in the Late Eighteenth and Early Nineteenth Centuries**

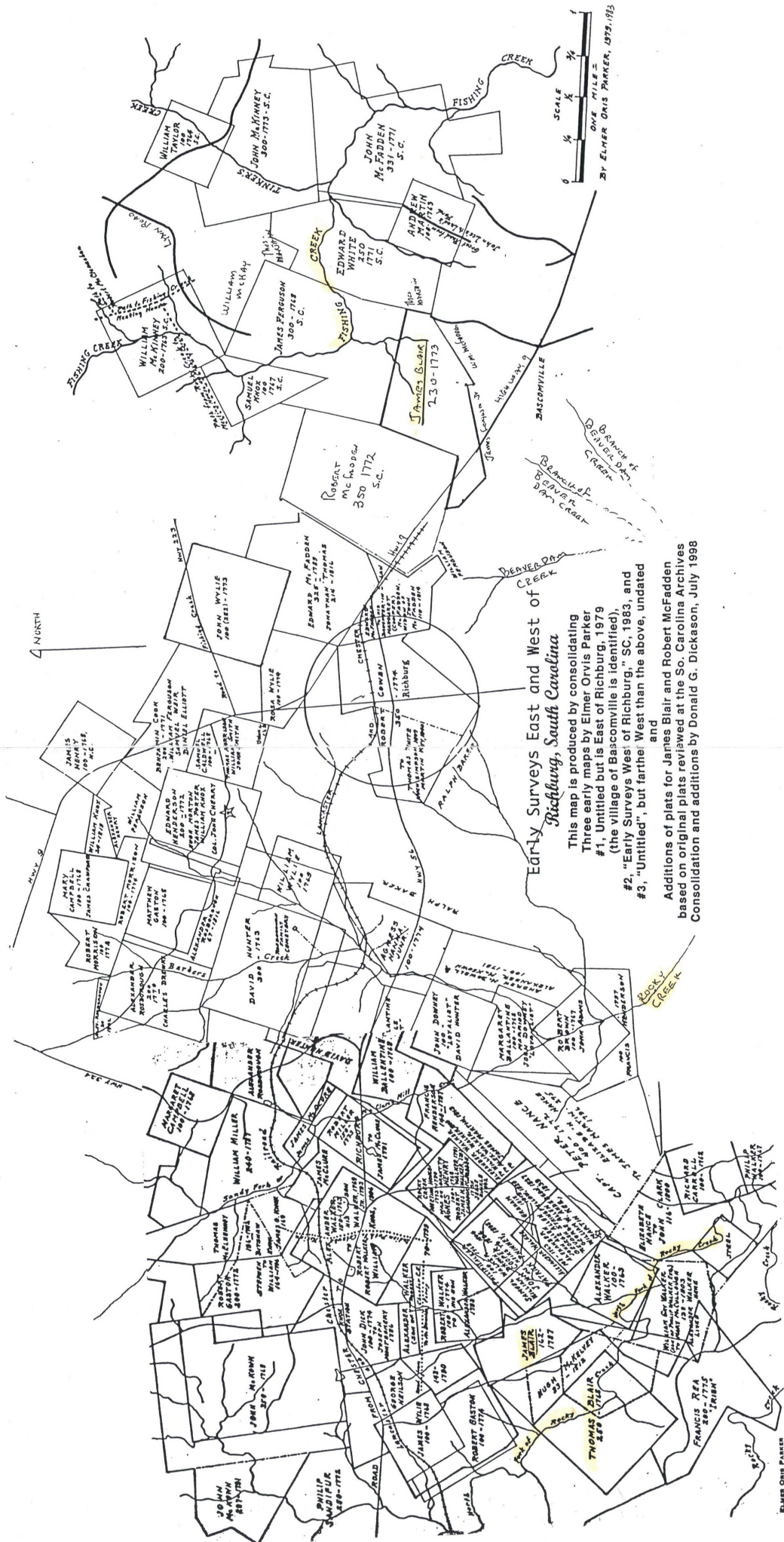
