

This Deed, Made the tenth day of April 1913 between Elvera C. Johnson, a single woman, of Silver hill, Alabama, of the first part and Charles Gustafson of the second part,

Witnesseth. That the party of the first part, in consideration of Three hundred and fifty (\$350.00) Dollars, to us in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is here by acknowledged, has bargained and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and deliver unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that real property in Baldwin County, Alabama, described as follows, to wit:

The North East Quarter of South West quarter of North East quarter (N.E. 1 of S.W. 1 of N.E. 1 \
Section Ten(10 \ Township Six(6 \ South, Range Three(3 \ East of St. Stephens Meridian in Alabama containing Ten(10 \ acres more or less

containing Ten(10) acres more or less.

Together with all appurtenances thereunto belonging, to have and to hold forever and against

any person lawfully claiming the same, said party of the first part shall forever warrant and defend.
